



Allegiant Christian School Code of Conduct Agreement

As teachers, students, and participants of Allegiant Christian School, we represent our school to those around us, the home educating community, and most importantly our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. In recognition of that we should behave in a manner consistent with the instruction presented in God's Word. Please teach your children the appropriate behavior and attitudes for compliance. By signing this document, parents, students, and participants acknowledge these rules and hereby agree to adhere to them. It is also understood the adult in charge of the activity has been delegated by the school (and you) to speak to anyone in attendance about inappropriate behavior. Thank You.

1. Have respect for authority figures. (I Peter 2:13; Romans 13:1)
2. Have an attitude of compassion for the differences, needs, or disabilities of others. (Matthew 7:12; James 2:1-9; Galatians 5:22-23)
3. Act and speak in a manner worthy of the God who calls you – unkind remarks, profanity, coarse jokes, conversation involving occult or sexual situations or other language unbecoming of a Christian is unacceptable at school functions. Avoid knowingly wearing gang symbols or colors. Dress modestly. Low-cut or extremely short dresses, overexposure of skin, faddy clothes that resemble underwear, or exposed undergarments are not permissible. (as per the discretion of the staff). (Prov. 11:22, 1 Tim. 2:9, 1 Cor. 6:19-20, Romans 12:2, 1 Tim. 2:9-10)
4. Even though you may not have a problem with certain behavior within your family, if you know something may be offensive to someone else, refrain from doing it! Respect the property and landscape of the event. (I Corinthians 8:7-13; Philippians 2:3-4; Romans 12:17b)
5. The use of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, vape or vaping products, the possession or uses of weapons, or illegal drugs are not permitted during any Allegiant Christian School function. Noncompliance with this item will result in expulsion from Allegiant Christian School and the student will be removed immediately. (Matthew 5:16; Galatians 5:19-21)
6. Physical altercations among students are strictly prohibited and may result in expulsion. (Matthew 18:15, 1 Thess. 5:9, Titus 3:2, Galatians 5:15)
7. Creating strife and division is unacceptable, whether in person or through social media. Noncompliance may result in expulsion. (Proverbs 28:25)
8. Wholesome friendships are encouraged between boys and girls. However, students and participants should look upon one another as brothers and sisters in Christ and refrain from demonstrating personal affection at all school functions, and whenever representing ACS. Although dancing may be enjoyed, slow dancing or anything resembling slow dancing will not be allowed. (Galatians 5:24; Romans 12:10; Ephesians 5:3)
9. We take the bible at its word regarding marriage and romantic relationships – they are between one man and one woman. Students and participants will not engage in same sex romantic relationships. Noncompliance with this item, either by an ACS student or his or her guest, will result in the ACS student's expulsion from Allegiant Christian School. (1 Corinthians 7:12, 1 Timothy 1:9-10)
10. We believe God created male and female in His own image, that gender is biological and determined at birth, according to each one's chromosomal make-up. Students and participants will not pretend to be a gender other than what was assigned at birth. Noncompliance with this item, either by an ACS student or his or her guest, will result in the ACS student's expulsion from Allegiant Christian School. (Gen 1:27, Deut. 22:5, 1 Cor. 6:19-20)
